

Garbage Collection is Changing in Cape Coral:

Effective January 12th, 2009 your garbage, recycling and yard waste will be collected on the same day, one time a week.

Garbage and Recycling Collection:

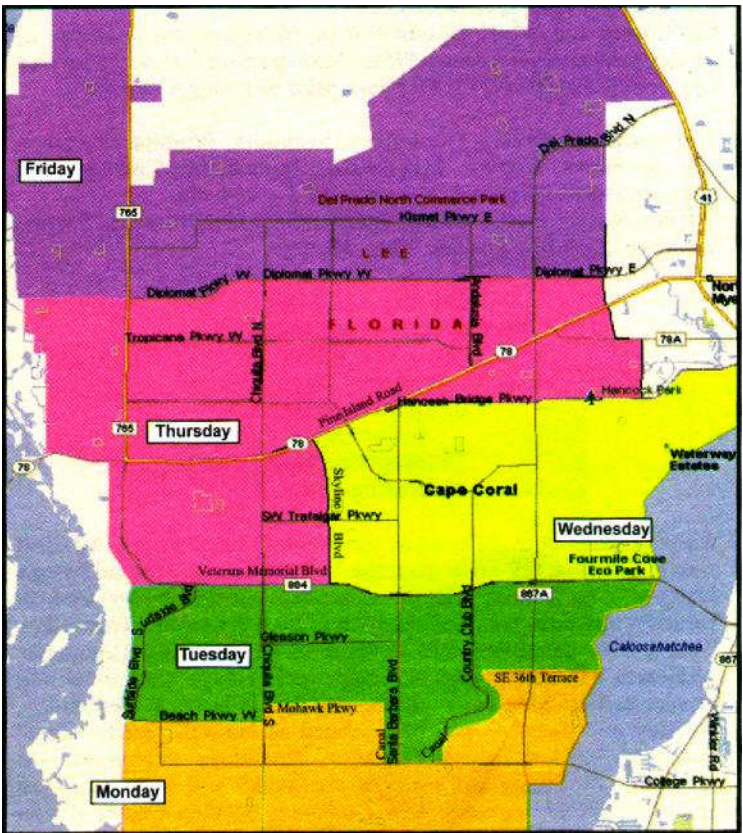
Garbage and Recycling must be placed within 3 feet of the curb by 6:00 am on your pick-up day.

Garbage should be in a 35 gallon or smaller container with a lid and a molded handle on each side. Garbage should not protrude from the container or bag. The container or bag should not exceed 50 pounds.

Bulk items will be picked up with your garbage. {e.g. sofas, chairs, mattresses, dishwashers, etc)

Recyclables should be in a bin and/or paper bag. Bottles, jars, and cans should be rinsed out and placed in the recycle bin. Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, paper, and junk mail should be in a **paper bag** on top of the recycling bin. Cardboard boxes should be broken down flat and no larger than 2 feet long **and** 4 feet wide, bundled or tied no more than 6 inches high.

DO NOT BLOCK ACCESS TO YOUR MAILBOX

Please do not place any recyclables in plastic bags.

Garbage and Recyclables should be placed on the left side of the driveway facing the house.

The City of Cape Coral provides each resident with recycling bins. If you don't have a bin contact WM Customer Service Center at (239) 334-4.115.

Yard Waste Collection

Yard Waste must be placed within 3 feet of the curb by 6:00 am on your pick-up day.

Yard Waste should be in a 35 gallon or smaller container, with a handle on each side or securely tied bundles that are no longer than 4 feet and weigh no more than 50 pounds per bundle or container. Unbundled palm fronds may be placed at the curb stacked neatly with the base facing the roadway. Do not mix palm fronds with other yard waste

Yard Waste should be placed on the right side of the driveway facing the house.

Hazardous Waste Collection

Waste Management **does not pickup** hazardous waste (e.g. paint, solvents, acid, chemicals, car batteries, motor oil or propane tanks). Contact Lee County at (239) 533-8000 or WWW.LEE-COUNTY.COM/SOLIDWASTE for the hazardous waste collection day.

Major Change ! !

Call 48 hours prior to your service day for white goods and electronics pickup.

Garbage, Recycling, Yard Waste, Electronics, White Goods and Bulk should be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.

Electronics and White Goods

Electronics and White Goods will be picked up on your day of service provided you contact Waste Management Customer Service Center at (239) 334-4115; 48 hours prior to your service day.

Electronics Devices— Computers, Monitors, Printers, Scanners, Fax Machines, Copier, Telephones, Televisions, Cathode Ray Tubes, Stereo Equipment, Microwaves, Lamps, etc.

White Goods—Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Stoves, Washing Machines, Dryers, Water Heaters,

Waste Management is closed on the holidays listed above. All trash pickup days that fall on or after the holiday will be delayed by one day (e.g. if the holiday falls on a Monday, you will be serviced on Tuesday, and Tuesdays' customers will be serviced on Wednesday, Wednesdays' customers will be serviced on Thursday, Thursdays' customers will be serviced on Friday and Fridays' customers will be serviced on Saturday). If the holiday falls on a Wednesday, Monday and Tuesday will be serviced as normal. Wednesdays' customers will be service Thursday, Thursdays' customers will be service on Friday and Fridays' customers will be serviced on Saturday.
